

## ICCC DRAG RACING RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

1. ICCC competition committee decisions will be final. They will settle and rule on all disputes.
2. Race participants agree that by entering an event, drag racing or road racing, the participant has the opportunity to inspect the event sites and acknowledges that the event is safe and suitable for racing. The participant acknowledges that he/she could suffer bodily injury or loss or damage to property. ICCC shall not be held liable. Participants waive all claims against the ICCC.
3. Drivers are prohibited from consuming illegal or illicit substances while in competition. No alcohol consumption will be allowed while competing.
4. All nitrous bottles must be mounted.
5. All cars running 11.49 or faster must have a flywheel shield.
6. All cars running 10.99 or faster must have a transmission shield.
7. All street tires must have a minimum of 1/16 tread depth.
8. All cars running 11.99 or faster must have a screw in valve stem in tubeless tires no space savers tires allowed.
9. Helmets are required for all racers.
10. Cars running faster than 14.00 can only have one person inside. Co-driver must be 21 years old.
11. All cars running faster than 9.99 the driver must wear NHRA protective clothing.
12. All drivers are required to wear full length pants, closed toe shoes and socks. Nylon or Nylon type clothing is prohibited.
13. All drivers must wear a seat belt.
14. All cars running 10.00 to 10.99 must have a roll bar.
15. All cars running faster than 10.00 will be required to be inspected for NHRA mandatory rules.
16. All racers must have a valid state driver's license.
17. All drivers are responsible for applying their own elapsed time on their car and for making sure it is correct.
