

Burnout Competition Guidelines

1. Eligibility

- All participants must be ICCC members in good standing.
- All drivers must hold a **valid driver's license**.

2. Competition Format

- This is a **single-car event** (one vehicle at a time).
- Each driver enters the burnout area and spins their drive wheels to produce smoke.
- Burnouts must last a **minimum of 15 seconds** and a **maximum of 30 seconds**.

3. Course & Location

- All burnout competitions must be held at the **race track** or another **approved designated area** selected by the Competition Committee.
- Safety zones and spectator boundaries must be established prior to the event.

4. Officials & Conduct

- Only competition officials are permitted inside the burnout zone during active runs.
- Spectators must remain in designated safe areas.
- Drivers must wear **seatbelts** and **closed-toe shoes** while competing.

5. Scoring & Placement

- The burnout competition will consist of **one open class** covering all competitors.
- Judging will be conducted by either:
 - **Spectators**, or
 - **Pre-selected competition personnel**, as determined by the committee.
- Points awarded:
 - 1st – 100 points
 - 2nd – 80 points
 - 3rd – 60 points

6. Tie-Breakers

- In case of a tie, a **burnout run-off** will determine final placement.

7. Safety & General Rules

- Fire extinguishers and safety crew must be on standby.
- Unsafe or reckless conduct may result in disqualification.
