The International Council of Corvette Clubs (ICCC) is proud to present the ICCC Competition Rules Handbook. This document has been prepared to establish clear, uniform, and enforceable guidelines for all sanctioned competition events conducted during ICCC conventions.

The purpose of this handbook is threefold:

1. To ensure the fair and consistent administration of all competitions.
2. To promote the highest standards of safety and integrity.
3. To preserve the spirit of fellowship and friendly competition that has defined the ICCC since its founding.

The competitions represented herein — from performance-based driving events such as Drag Racing, King & Queen of the Hill, and Gymkhana, to precision contests like the Road Rally and Push Car, and skill-based activities including Car Shows, Golf, and Table Games, collectively embody the diverse talents and enthusiasm of our members. Each event is a reflection of the ICCC's commitment to excellence, inclusivity, and the enduring legacy of Corvette ownership.

This handbook shall serve as the official reference for competitors, judges, and event officials. All participants are expected to adhere to the rules contained within, and to conduct themselves with the highest degree of sportsmanship and respect for their fellow members. The ICCC Competition Committee shall serve as the governing authority in interpreting and applying these rules, with all decisions rendered as final.

With this handbook, we reaffirm our shared commitment to the principles of integrity, camaraderie, and the celebration of Corvette culture.

Drag Racing Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- ICCC members in good standing.
- Men and women compete separately.

Competition Format

- Head-to-head drag races on a sanctioned strip.
- Winners advance until final placements are determined.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st – 150 points
- 2nd – 125 points
- 3rd – 100 points

King & Queen of the Hill Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- ICCC members only.
- Separate Men's (King) and Women's (Queen) divisions.

Competition Format

- Fastest car drag race.
- Single elimination heats until winners determined.

Gymkhana Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- ICCC members only.
- Men and women compete separately.

Competition Format

- Timed precision driving course.
- Best time with penalties applied determines winner.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st – 100 points
- 2nd – 80 points
- 3rd – 70 points

Road Rally Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- Registered ICCC event participants. ICCC Associate Members may act as navigators.
- Each car must have a driver and navigator.
- Drivers must hold valid licenses.

Competition Format

- Precision navigation rally, not speed.
- Objective: Arrive closest to rally master's ideal time.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st – 85 points
- 2nd – 75 points
- 3rd – 65 points
- Penalties: Missed turn +5 min, Missed checkpoint +10 min, Reckless driving =
Disqualification.

Push Car Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- ICCC members only.

Competition Format

- Team event: One pushes while the other steers.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st – 100 points
- 2nd – 75 points
- 3rd – 50 points

Jack & Tire Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- ICCC members only.

Competition Format

- Timed event: Jack up Corvette, remove and replace tire.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st - 95 points
- 2nd - 70 points
- 3rd - 45 points

Burnout Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- ICCC members only.
- Drivers must have valid licenses.

Competition Format

- Single-car burnouts lasting 15–30 seconds.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st – 100 points
- 2nd – 80 points
- 3rd – 60 points
- Judged on volume of smoke and control.

Exhaust Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- ICCC members only.

Competition Format

- Each car allowed up to 3 revs.
- Judged 50% loudness (decibel) and 50% tone/quality.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st – 100 points
- 2nd – 80 points
- 3rd – 60 points

Stereo Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- ICCC members only.

Competition Format

- Up to 60-second music selection.
- Judged 40% volume, 30% clarity, 30% overall sound.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st – 100 points
- 2nd – 80 points
- 3rd – 60 points

Light Show Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- ICCC members only.

Competition Format

- 60-second display of lighting systems.
- Judged 40% creativity, 30% presentation, 30% visual impact.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st – 100 points
- 2nd – 80 points
- 3rd – 60 points

Golf (Best Ball) Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- ICCC members only.

Competition Format

- Best Ball format (1-4 player teams).
- Team score = lowest score per hole.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st - 100 points
- 2nd - 80 points
- 3rd - 60 points

Spades Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- ICCC members only, teams of two.

Competition Format

- Standard partnership Spades, to 500 points.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st – 75 points
- 2nd – 50 points
- 3rd – 25 points

Dominoes Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- ICCC members only.

Competition Format

- Standard double-six Dominoes, to 150 points.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st – 75 points
- 2nd – 50 points
- 3rd – 25 points

Bid Whist Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

- ICCC members only, teams of two.

Competition Format

- Standard partnership Bid Whist, to 7 books or set score.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st – 75 points
- 2nd – 50 points
- 3rd – 25 points

Elix Withers Trophy – Championship Guidelines

The Elix Withers Trophy is awarded to the competitor with the highest total points across all convention competitions.

Tie-Breakers

1. Most 1st place finishes.
2. If tied, most 2nd place finishes.
3. If tied, most 3rd place finishes.
4. Final decision by Competition Committee.
