

Push Car Competition

Eligibility

- ICCC Members only.

Competition Format

- Team event where one participant pushes while the other steers a Corvette a set distance.

Course & Location

- Conducted in a designated area with clear start and finish lines.

Officials & Conduct

- Competition officials oversee start/finish.
- Spectators restricted to safe viewing zones.

Scoring & Placement

- 1st – 100 points
- 2nd – 75 points
- 3rd – 50 points

Tie-Breakers

- In case of a tie, a rematch heat will determine final standings.

Safety & General Rules

- Must have five team members to compete.
- Car must remain in gear (neutral) with brakes functional.
- Cars can't be changed or substituted during the competition, except generation for generation. Example C4 for C4.
- Participants must wear closed toe shoes.

- This competition can be a mixed gender event of any combination.
- If there is an all-female ICCC corvette club competing, a one car length advantage will be given to the female team.
- Once you have staged your car, if your car moves before the start signal, you lose the race.
- If team crosses the center line, they lose the race.
- The first car to cross the finish line wins the race.
- If there is an odd number of cars entered, there will be a bye for the car with the fastest time.
- There will be 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards for three or more entrants.
- Safety spotters will be present at all times.

Competition Chairman has the authority to change or modify events based on members participation.
