



# ICCC Show Your Ride Corvette Show

## Participant Guide

Welcome to the International Council of Corvette Clubs (ICCC) annual **Show Your Ride** Corvette Show. This guide is designed to help participants understand registration, judging criteria, scoring, and how to best prepare their Corvette for judging.

---

### 1. About the Show

The ICCC Show Your Ride is a **judged Corvette show**. Vehicles are judged on **cleanliness, presentation, and attention to detail**. Each vehicle is judged independently and is **not compared** to other vehicles in its class.

---

### 2. Registration Overview

- Registration is completed **online only** through Car Show Pro  
<https://carshowpro.com/index.php/login>
- Each vehicle must be registered **individually**
- One email address per vehicle entry
- Registration is **first come, first served**

Participants wishing to be parked near club members, friends, or family are encouraged to register at the same time. Zone requests may be submitted but are **not guaranteed**.

### 3. How Judging Works

Judging is based strictly on **cleanliness and presentation**. Vehicles are evaluated in several categories, each with a maximum number of points. Judges are looking for cleanliness, not perfection or originality.

## 4. Scoring Breakdown (100 Total Points)

### Paint – 20 Points

- Finish (clean, free of dirt, dust, bugs, wax residue) – 15 points
- Special paint effects – 5 points

### Body – 20 Points

- Body work, fit, and finish – 10 points
- Glass (windshield, mirrors, rear glass free of smudges) – 5 points
- Exterior accessories – 5 points

### Wheels and Tires – 15 Points

- Wheels clean and free of brake dust and road grime – 10 points
- Custom wheels – 5 points

### Interior – 20 Points

- Upholstery condition and cleanliness – 5 points
- Dash and console – 5 points
- Carpet and floor mats – 5 points
- Interior accessories – 5 points

### Engine – 20 Points

- Engine cleanliness – 15 points
- Engine accessories – 5 points

### Display – 5 Points

- Overall presentation of the vehicle and display area

## **5. Judging Detail by Area**

### **Exterior**

- Vehicle free of dirt, dust, bugs, tar, and wax residue
- Windshield, mirrors, and rear glass clean and smudge free
- Exhaust tips clean

### **Wheels and Tires**

- Wheels free of brake dust, dirt, and road tar
- Tires clean and reasonably dressed
- Wheel wells clean and free of gravel, sand, or debris

### **Interior**

- Seats, dash, visors clean and well maintained
- Carpets and floor mats free of dirt and debris
- Interior glass clean and smudge free

### **Engine Compartment**

- Engine clean and free of oil, dirt, and smudges
- Engine bay clean and detailed
- Frame rails clean
- Electrical harnesses and hoses clean

## **6. Display Guidelines**

- Display items should enhance, not clutter, the vehicle
- Area around the car should be clean and orderly
- Display score is based on neatness and presentation, not cost

## **7. Tips for a Successful Show**

- Clean your vehicle thoroughly the day before and morning of the show
- Pay attention to often overlooked areas (wheel wells, exhaust tips, interior glass)
- Remove unnecessary personal items from the interior
- Arrive at assigned time to allow time for final touch ups

## **8. Final Notes**

We purposely use outside judges (Corvette Memphis) who volunteer their time and strive to be fair and consistent. Please treat them with kindness and respect, they have no ulterior motives on who wins. The goal of the ICCC Show Your Ride is to celebrate Corvette pride, craftsmanship, and community.
